# **Craigieburn Local Rules**

Rules to be read in conjunction with the rules of golf.

#### 1.Free drop from:

- 1.1 All trees under two club lengths in height (**Must** take relief).
- 1.2 All cracks in the general area.
- 1.3 All internal roads and paths.
- 1.4 Staked trees and shrubs.
- 1.5 Embedded stones through the green. Interference with a player's stance is deemed not to be of itself, interference.

#### 2. Out Of Bounds:

- 2.1 Beyond any boundary fence or boundary stake which bounds the course.
- 2.2 Vehicle parking areas Permanent and Temporary
- 2.3 Practice fairway and chipping area to the left of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> holes as defined by the cut line of the area.

#### 3. Ground Under Repair:

3.1 All works designated by white stakes or roped off areas.

#### 4. Immovable Obstructions:

4.1 Sprinkler heads, water control boxes/covers, safety fences, sand boxes, benches/seats, steps, hand rails, water fountains, electrical pits/boxes/covers, distance markers, hole information signs at teeing areas, other signage which is immovable.

#### 5. Penalty Areas:

- 5.1 All creeks and Dams (Water Hazards RED)
- 5.2 The dam alongside the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> holes as indicated by the stakes.
- 5.3 The dam between the 12<sup>th</sup> green and the 13<sup>th</sup> tee as defined by the cut line.
- 5.4 The creek which runs between the 1<sup>st</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>, 9th and 17<sup>th</sup> holes as defined by the cut line.
- 5.5 The creek which runs through the 10<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> holes as defined by the cut line.

#### 6. Abnormal Course Conditions:

- 6.1 Tyre tracks (except push buggy tracks).
- 6.2 Garden Beds
- 6.3 Bare patches on the closely mown area in the general area (divots are not bare patches).

# 2025 Syllabus and Competition Entry Fees

During the luncheon address at the second round of our Championships at Melton V.G.C, our President Alan, informed the members that next year's Syllabus has been finalised and there have been several changes. Craigieburn G.C. will no longer feature and 2 events will be played at Medway G.C. i.e. the Annual match against Melbourne Vets on January 20<sup>th</sup> and also on the 7<sup>th</sup> July.

Our annual general meeting in February will take place at Bacchus Marsh G.C. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> February and Gisborne will feature later in the year on 10<sup>th</sup> November.

# VVGA State Championship Corowa Golf Club October 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Corowa Golf Club was the venue for the VVGA State Championship on October 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Sadly, the field of 88 players was about a dozen short of the numbers we had anticipated attending the event.

Conditions were ideal and a queue of eager veterans waited patiently for the AGM to conclude to gain access to the registration area. Once in there, they were allocated tees and treated to a lunch pack to enjoy during their round.

With all players registered early, the field was welcomed by President Ern Kraulis and Corowa Golf Operations Manager Nathan Thomas briefed players on local information prior to sending them out to their allocated tees for the 11:00am shotgun start. It was somewhat disappointing that many golfers decided to head out to tees prior to the briefing.

The event format was explained; The stableford format would produce 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in A, B and C grades while the State Champion would be determined by the best gross score over the 36 holes. Golfers were reminded that if they wished to compete for the State Champion title, they must putt out on all holes.

Twenty degrees and a slight breeze were enjoyed. The flies appeared to have bred well and were extremely sticky. (As opposed to the greens that were just tricky!) Aeroguard and Bushman certainly got a good workout.

Afternoon tea and refreshments were enjoyed while results were being prepared. The ball rundown and nearest the pins were then presented before players were reminded of the 9:00am start on Tuesday.

A large number of veterans returned and enjoyed dinner in the dining room and shared their experiences of the days play.
