The **Order of Merit (OOM)** competition proved a popular initiative when introduced in 2019 by then President Kerry Bayly. During 2022, the committee chose to re-badge this event and it is now named the Kerry Bayly Order of Merit.

The OOM is conducted across the monthly events, commencing with our January event and concluding with the November event. OOM Prizes will be distributed at our final event of the year in December.

Each month points will be awarded to all participants; firstly on a sliding scale down to 30th position with 200 points going to the best score on the day and then points allocated, on a sliding scale, down to 11 points for 30th position. The Australian Count-Back system is used to determine placings down to 30th position, all remaining participants receive 10 points.

- From 2021 onwards, there will be no additional points for grade winners.
- From 2021 the OOM scoring will be automatically generated and the overall scoring will be available in One Golf shortly after each round.
- The minimum points that any player in the top 30 will receive is 11.
- Members must play at least 6 monthly events to be eligible for the annual prizes with their top 8
 points only being counted towards the final OOM results.
- Points will only be allocated to financial members of the Hume Veterans Golf Club.

Positions on the OOM table will also be used to select players to represent Hume Vets in the annual VVGA Teams Event in September.

Werribee Golf Club Local Rules

(To be read in conjunction with the rules of golf any Temporary Local Rules)

- 1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27-1):** Beyond any fence and/or white stakes with black tops bounding the course (Including fence surrounding the driving range and curators complex)
- 2. **STAKES, TREES AND SHRUBS (Including guard/stake):** If a tree or staked shrub interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b (i). The ball may be cleaned when lifted. The stakes (and/or guards) are immovable obstructions.
- 3. **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS:** All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2.
- 4. **WATERHAZARDS:** Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes and/or lines. Note: The stakes are immovable instructions.
- 5. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** The following areas are defined as ground under repair: Those areas, the margin of which are defined by white stakes, white lines and/or GUR signage. **PLAY IS PROHIBITED** from the above areas. Relief **MUST** be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1. Note: All GUR stakes and signs are immovable obstructions.
- 6. HOLE COVERS: Metal Hole Covers on Putting Greens are immovable obstructions Rule 24-2(b) (iii) applies.

Conditions of Play

VVGA 4BBB STROKE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. All entrants (both men and women) must be a financial member of the Victoria Veteran Association (VVGA) and a Golf Australia (GA) home Golf Club.

2. All entry fees must be paid at the time of entry

3. The Council of the VVGA shall have the entire management of the tournament including handicapping and the power to alter a handicap at any time during the Tournament.

4. A Golf Australia (GA) Handicap limit of 36 (men) and 45

(women) applies to all Championship events

5. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf of St Andrews and any modifications set out in local rules.

6. The Match Committee of the VVGA shall have the power to deal with and resolve any dispute or protest which must be lodged with the VVGA Captain (or deputy) within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

7. The Match Committee's decision is final. The Council of the VVGA may, in the event of adverse weather or any other reason, either shorten the event or schedule it for another day.

8. In case of tied scores, the VVGA Match Committee shall determine the manner for deciding the winner.

9. Entry fees paid will not be refunded if a scratching is made after two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the Tournament.

10. Competitors may win only one (1) major trophy for the day.

11. There is no countback for the ball competition.

12. Trophy winners are eliminated from the ball competition.

Note: - To promote fellowship amongst players, the draw will be arranged, where possible, to have entrants playing with competitors from other Districts-Players with private carts must be fully insured and abide by club rules.


